DRESS CODE

Dress code is applicable from arrival until the end of the school day, and during After Care, if the student remains on campus.

Shirts

- Polos (long and short sleeve) and turtleneck shirts are permitted. Only the top buttons on a polo may be unbuttoned. All other buttons, including those on the collar must be buttoned. They must be plain, but can have the CCA logo.
- WEDNESDAY CHAPEL:** Gentleman must wear a button down collared shirt with tie/bow tie. Acceptable button down colors are: white, black, solid blue (light blue or french blue are ok), white/blue pinstripe.
- No long sleeve shirts are allowed to be worn under short sleeved shirt.
- Dress sweaters in SOLID uniform shirt colors are permitted in the following styles: Long sleeve (crew or v-neck) pullover, sleeveless (crew or v-neck pullover), cardigan (buttons or zipper). Uniform shirt must be worn.
- FRIDAY DRESS:** students may wear CCA Spiritwear shirts including hoodies with uniform bottoms.



1/4 zip, crew neck sweatshirts, and long sleeved t-shirts may be worn all week, only if they have the CCA logo. No polo is required underneath crew neck or long sleeved t-shirts.

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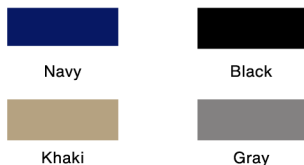


DRESS CODE

Other than the Schoolbelles Plaid and Herringbone skirts, all other uniform pieces may be purchased ANYWHERE. (Schoolbelles code: s1661)

Pants/Shorts



- Shorts may only be worn 1st-6th grade, from May 1st until September 30th.
- Pants must be worn at the waist
- May not be inappropriately tight or inappropriately oversized, but should be loose enough for normal movement.
- **Prohibited:** Denim, Joggers, pants with holes, leggings (except under skirts). Denim and joggers may be worn on specified dress down days, but still must not be inappropriately tight or contain holes.
- If pants/shorts do **NOT** conform to the dress code, administration will require that alternate bottoms be brought to school or the student will be sent home

Shoes

Acceptable Shoes:

- Black, brown, navy or gray dress shoes
- Topsider (Sperry) style shoes in suede, leather, or canvas
- Athletic tennis shoes - must have closed toe and covered heel, solid color (no pattern), clean and in good repair



- **NO** sandals, Birkenstocks, boots, slippers, mules, clogs, five-fingered or vented water shoes
- Students **MUST** have a separate pair of tennis shoes for gym
- Crocs and boots/booties may be worn on **FRIDAY ONLY**

Acceptable Skirts/Jumpers



- Skirts must be no shorter than 2" above the crease of the back of the knee
- Two-kick pleat, pleat kilt, and split skirt styles are approved
- Strongly suggested that girls wear shorts, leggings, or tights under their skirts in navy, black, gray, or white. Must be solid, no pattern or lace.
- Girls in Grades 1-4 may wear jumpers in any style of skirt, or a polo dress (in uniform polo colors) with the same length requirements of skirts

Socks

Socks must match and be a **SOLID** color. **NO NEON**
